DIRECTIONS	<p><u>Boil-Out</u>: Use 2 to 6 oz. per gallon at 180° to 200°F.</p> <p><u>Bottle Washing</u>: Use 1/2 to 2 oz. per gallon of water.</p> <p><u>Soak Tank</u>: Use 2 to 8 oz. depending on the job. Heat up to 160° to 180°F and agitate.</p> <p><u>Foam</u>: Mix with foam additive and other additives. From 1/2 to a 50/50 solution may be used depending on the job requirements.</p>
