

CITRI-KLEAN

DESCRIPTION	CITRI-KLEAN contains natural d-Limonene. It is a low- to moderate-foaming degreaser that efficiently cleans and degreases. It is formulated for use in a wide variety of cleaning applications to remove petroleum grease and oil, cooking grease, food soils, soot, ink, tar, soap film, adhesives, dirt, grime, rubber marks, and other organic and inorganic soils. Safe for use on all metal surfaces, stainless steel, polished floors, concrete, porcelain, laminate, glass, ceramic, cured paint, colorfast fabrics and textiles, and most washable surfaces. Do not use on materials containing rubber.
DIRECTIONS	Remove all food products from area before using CITRI-KLEAN. For light soils, dilute 2 to 5 oz. per gallon of water. For moderate soils, Dilute 6 to 10 oz. per gallon of water. For heavy soils, dilute 15 to 30 oz. per gallon of water. As a room deodorizer, add one capful to 20 oz. of water. Apply diluted cleaning solution to surface by brush, mop, sponge, trigger sprayer, pressure sprayer, foam generator, or use in soak-tank applications. Allow solution to remain in contact with soils for 1 to 2 minutes, then agitate or scrub surface. Rinse surfaces after use. Consult your representative for specific applications and concentrations in your plant.
