## **ACIDIQUAT 4**

DESCRIPTION ACIDIQUAT 4 is an acidic four-chain quaternary ammonia sanitizer designed to meet

today's needs for an effective environmental sanitizer for the food industry. It is EPA Registered and USDA Authorized for use in meat and poultry plants. It contains four forms of quaternary for effectiveness over a wide range of bacterial, viral and other

micro-organic contaminants including Listeria.

DIRECTIONS After cleaning and rinsing equipment, add 1 to 2 oz. per 4 gallons of warm water (200 to

400 ppm active quaternary) and apply to equipment with a cloth, brush, mechanical spray or immersion. Treated surfaces should remain wet for at least 60 seconds followed by adequate draining and air drying. Do not rinse with water. ACIDIQUAT 4 is not meant to be used as a one-step cleaner/sanitizer. It is important to rinse and remove all sediment prior

to any sanitizing.
