

JELL-ADD Caustic Gel

DESCRIPTION	JELL-ADD is a powdered gelling agent used in conjunction with other detergents. It is a product that produces a thick gel and is to be mixed with water. It is important to keep mixture agitated until sprayed onto equipment.
DIRECTIONS	Use 0.5 to 1 lb. every 10 to 20 lbs. of detergent. Also use at least 20 gallons of water for each gel charge. Usage rates will vary with each type of cleaning. In food processing plants, always rinse with potable water after use. Note: It is important to keep mixture agitated until sprayed on to equipment.
