

PREMIUM PEROXIDE 5

5% Peracetic Acid Solution

DESCRIPTION PREMIUM PEROXIDE 5 is a broad-spectrum microbiocide used for the control of bacteria, bacterial spores, fungi, and yeast. PREMIUM PEROXIDE 5 can be used in a wide range of industrial applications, including no-rinse sanitizer on food and beverage processing equipment, general purpose hard surface disinfectant, and bacteria and slime (deposit) control in water treatment applications.

PREMIUM PEROXIDE 5 conforms to the FDA standards regarding sanitizing solutions as outlined in 21 CFR 5178.1010. EPA Registration No. 54289-3

DIRECTIONS PREMIUM PEROXIDE 5 is recommended for use on pre-cleaned surfaces such as equipment, pipeline, tanks, vats, fillers, evaporators, pasteurizers, and aseptic equipment, in dairies, breweries, wineries, beverage and food processing/packing plants, egg processing/packing equipment surfaces, and eating establishments.

Procedure: After removing gross particulate matter with a warm water flush and washing equipment with detergent or cleaning solution, followed by a potable water rinse. Fill closed systems with diluted sanitizer solution. Allow surfaces to drain thoroughly before resuming operation.

Concentration: 1 to 1.5oz. to 5 gallons of potable water, (This will provide 88 ppm to 130 ppm) for sanitizing and hard surface disinfectants. 3.5 oz to 10 gallons of potable water, (this will provide 134 ppm) for fogging and food contact surfaces. 12.8 to 19.2oz to 10 gallons of potable water, (this will provide 549 ppm to 823 ppm) for only cleaning fresh water membrane systems.

Temperature: 40° to 104°F (5° to 40°C).

Sanitizing Contact Time: 1 minute or greater.

PREMIUM PEROXIDE 5 is safe and effective under the intended conditions of use as outlined on the product label or specified in a Sanitation Standard Operation Procedure (SSOP) as part of a HACCP Program.
