

# Ultra Dry S Lube

Ultra Dry S Lube is a fully synthetic chain lubricant, specifically designed for use on plastic, other non-metal chains and stainless steel for the transportation of product packages on table top conveyors in the food and beverage industry when a water-free or non-aqueous operation is required. Ultra Dry S Lube is pH-neutral and is suitable for a wide variety of applications.

- Reduces microbiological contamination

### Directions for Use

#### Method

Through a central conveyor lubricant dosing system, the concentrated Ultra Dry S Lube is applied, at the start of your operation, to the conveyor belt and periodically during the day depending on the type of package being run on the conveyors and the speed of the system. Due to the fine layer of non-aqueous (water free) lubricant on the belt, cardboard packaging, PET bottles, etc. are transported smoothly without damage. At the same time, the conveyor belts are kept clean, which reduces microbiological contamination.

#### Concentration

Using a brush in direct contact with the belt, apply for about 30-60 seconds every 2-8 hours, depending on type of conveyor material. For example, plastic-plastic may be every 6-8 hours; plastic-metal may be every 3-5 hours; and metal-metal may be every 1-2 hours. The preferred method is to use an amp check meter on the largest conveyor motor, and when amp load increases noticeably it would be time to apply another cycle of Ultra Dry S Lube.

### IF ON SKIN
