Concentration

Sanitation of Food Processing Equipment and other hard non-porous surfaces in food contact locations: apply a solution of 1 oz. BioHatch[™] in 4 gallons of water (150 ppm active). Surface should remain wet for at least one minute followed by an adequate draining and air drying.

Disinfection of Poultry Equipment, Animal Quarter and Kennel: after thoroughly cleaning, disinfect with a solution of ½ oz. of BioHatch[™] in 1 gallon of water using a mop, cloth, or brush. Surfaces should remain wet for at least 10 minutes.

Sanitizing Food Eggs: To sanitize previously cleaned food grade eggs and egg product processing plants, spray with 1 oz. BioHatch[™] in 4 gallons of water (150 ppm active).
