Method and recommended coverage

Concentration

Klean Drain is applied following the 4-step environmental and sanitation program.

Step 1: remove scrap and clutter from area

Step 2: Thoroughly foam the entire area with an alkaline foam cleaner

Step 3: Using powdered caustic floor cleaner and drain-specific brush, thoroughly scrub drain area

Step 4: Thoroughly rinse, inspect, and flood sanitize using designated sanitizer at proper concentration.

Safety Information

IF ON SKIN

Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED

Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.
